The inexpensive form of traveling by train is estimated at about \$15 per student. The SDO will check on the exact cost.
- Harold added that students may be reluctant to attend the SSCCC conference because it is scheduled back-to-back with the CCCSAA conference and is very close to Halloween. Attendees of this conference will probably be a different set of students than those attending the CCCSAA conference. President

Jessica Lopez may select who will attend or initiate a lottery process on who will go.

- Decision to rent a van or train will take place at the next senate meeting. The type of transportation used is not an issue as long as ASO remains within the approved budget.
