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# How to Register for Kid's College



OFFICE HOURS: 8:30am-4:00pm Monday-Friday. Please note special summer hoursoffice closes at 4pm. Closed weekends and holidays: Monday, May 30, 2016 (Memorial Day), Friday June 10, 2016 (ECC Summer Holiday), Friday June 17, 2016 (ECC Summer Holiday), Friday June 24, 2016 (ECC Summer Holiday), and Monday, July 4, 2016 (Independence Day Holiday).

Not-for-credit classes: Not for K-12 or college credit. No grades assigned. Grade levels indicate the grade level children will be entering in the fall.

Release & Medical Consent Form Required: A completed and signed release and medical consent form is required upon registering your child for Kid's College. The Kid's College Welcome Packet will be sent to you after you have completed enrollment/payment for Kid's College classes. The Kid's College Welcome Packet will include the release and medical consent form, an emergency contact form, a pick-up/drop-off authorization form, a campus map indicating the location of the Kid's College drop-off/p-up location, a code of conduct form and general Kid's College information.

Lunch supervision provided for Grades 1-5 enrolled full day. Students are required to provide their own snacks and lunches.

After Care Options/Fees: Aftercare for Grades 1-5 from 3:00pm-4:00pm is available for an extra fee of \$10 daily or \$30 weekly. Afternoon Study Hall for Grades 6-8 from 2:15pm-4:00pm is available for an extra fee of \$10 daily or \$30 weekly. Call 310-660-6460 to enroll in After Care/Afternoon Study Hall. Advance registration required.

Easy drop-off and pick-up: The Drop off/Pick up location opens 30 minutes before each class starts and closes 30 minutes after each class ends. Do not drop off your child earlier than 30 minutes prior to class start time. Do not pick up your child later than 30 minutes after the class end time.

Kids in grades 1-5, must be signed in and out each day when you drop them off and pick them up at the Kid's College Drop-off/Pick-up location located at the corner of Crenshaw and Manhattan Beach Blvd (see map). Look for the Kid's College signs! Kid's College staff and instructors will be at the location to welcome and walk your grades 1-5 child to and from class each day. Important: Drop-off opens at 8:30am and pick-up closes after the last class in the afternoon at 3:30pm. After 3:30pm, parents of kids grades 1-5 will incur a daily \$10 aftercare fee and are to pick-up their child at the Community Education office/Kid's College lounge (MBBM 137) until 4:00pm when the office closes.

Kids in grades 6-12, on the first day of the start of each new two-week class are to be dropped off and picked up at the Kid's College Drop-off/Pick-up location where they will be escorted by their instructor to their classroom. After the first day, they may walk themselves to and from their classroom. Kid's College staff at the Drop-off/Pick-up location will be available to guide them to their room if needed after the first day of class.

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





Attention food operation owners, kitchen managers and food handler supervisors! This one day class prepares you to take the examination needed to certify or recertify you as a Certified Food Protection Manager (CFPM). This certification requirement is mandated by California State law for all retail food operations (restaurants, cafes, markets, mobile carts, caterers, etc.) and is enforced by local health departments. A CFPM is a certificate that is to be obtained by the owner or employee of food facilities that prepare, handle, or serve nonprepackaged potentially hazardous food. There shall be at least one CFPM person at each food facility. 

#### TRACING THE O.J. SIMPSON TRIAL 1-DAY EXCURSION

Twenty years after the infamous "trial of the century," several media companies have recently presented television programs that closely examined the trial's people and events. You can retrace many of the actual and approximate locations where these people and events emerged. With step-on guide John Powers, who produced a local theatricalization of the trial, you will begin the journey in the Redondo Beach neighborhood from where Los Angeles Police Department homicide detective Mark Fuhrman began his investigation. Like Fuhrman, you will arrive at Nicole Brown's condo on Bundy Avenue where evidence will impel police to rush to O.J. Simpson's residence on Rockingham. Along the way, you will experience the location



of restaurant Mezzaluna where Nicole ate her last meal and St. Martin de Tours church

where her funeral was held soon after. You will have an opportunity to discuss and voice your thoughts about the trial and learn information that may shock you. There will be timeout for lunch on your own at Roscoe's Chicken & Waffles and again ample



opportunity to discuss the facts and perceptions of the trial. Afterwards, the tour will drive by the Criminal Courts Building in downtown Los Angeles with Powers

offering many facets of the case that will challenge and expand your understanding.


