

The role of the Professional Child Visitation Monitor is to be a neutral party who observes behavior. In this Standard 5.20, 14 hour training, you will be thoroughly trained to be an Independent Professional Monitor or register with a Monitoring Agency. Your training will include monitor procedures, visitation techniques, child abuse reporting, stages of child development, codes and standards, preparing reports and declarations, handling subpoenas, and marketing your business. 
