Not-for-credit classes: Not for K-12 or college credit. No grades assigned. Grade levels indicate the grade level children will be entering in the fall.

Release & Medical Consent Form Required: A completed and signed release and medical consent form is required upon registering your child for Kid's College. The Kid's College Welcome Packet will be sent to you after you have completed enrollment/payment for Kid's College classes. The Kid's College Welcome Packet will include the release and medical consent form, an emergency contact form, a pick-up/drop-off authorization form, a campus map indicating the location of the Kid's College drop-off/p-up location, a code of conduct form and general Kid's College information.

Lunch supervision provided for Grades 1-8 enrolled full day. Students are required to provide their own snacks and lunches.


After Care Options/Fees: Aftercare for Grades 1-5 from 3:00pm-5:00pm is available for an extra fee of \$10 daily or \$30 weekly. After Care for Grades 6-8 from 2:15pm-5:00pm is available for an extra fee of \$10 daily or \$30 weekly. Call 310-660-6460 to enroll in After Care. Advance registration required.



Easy drop-off and pick-up: Drop off and pick up your kid at the Drop off/Pick up location and your child will be escorted to/from his/her classroom. The Drop off/Pick up location (see map on page 65) opens 30 minutes before each class starts and closes 30 minutes after each class ends. Do not drop off your child earlier than 30 minutes prior to class start time. Do not pick up your child later than 30 minutes after the class end time.


Kids in grades 1-8, must be signed in and out each day when you drop them off and pick them up at the Kid's College Drop-off/Pick-up location **located at the corner of Crenshaw and Manhattan Beach Blvd (see map).** Look for the Kid's College signs! Kid's College staff and instructors will be at the location to welcome and walk your grades 1-8 child to and from class each day. **Important: Drop-off opens at 8:30am and pick-up closes after the last class in the afternoon at 3:30pm. After 3:30pm, parents of kids grades 1-8 will incur a daily \$10 aftercare fee and are to pick-up their child at the Community Education office/Kid's College lounge (MBBM 137) until 5:00pm when the Kid's College lounge closes.**

Kids in grades 9-12, on the first day of the start of each new class are to be dropped off and picked up at the Kid's College Drop-off/Pick-up location where they will be escorted by their instructor to their classroom. After the first day, they may walk themselves to and from their classroom. Kid's College staff at the Drop-off/Pick-up location will be available to guide them to their room if needed after the first day of class.

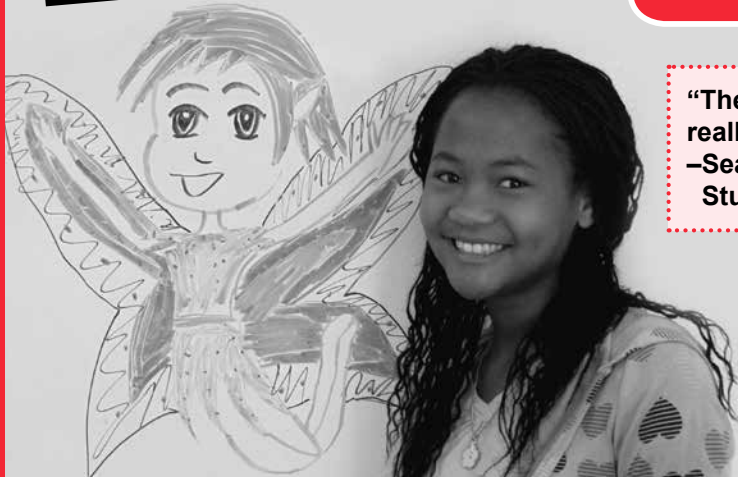

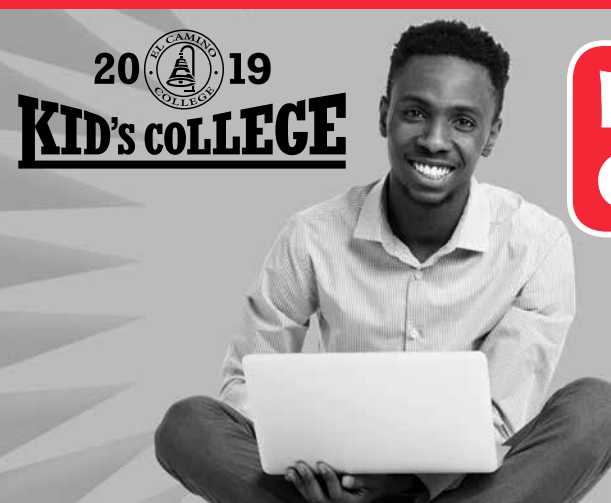

Academic Chess: Beginning to Advanced Levels

(Grades 1-5) #460094 & #460130 (Grades 6-8) #460130

Did you know that playing chess increases your child's IQ? Chess also teaches children to think deeply, gain confidence, solve problems, develop patience, evaluate positions, compete well, visualize results, and strategize and plan. **Instructor:** Academic Chess

Algebra (Grades 9-12) #410030

Learn the fundamentals of first-year algebra such as distributive law, solving linear equations, graphing by plotting points, using zeros, using slope-Y intercept form, and absolute value and linear inequalities. Other topics will include solving systems of equations by graphing, substitution and addition, exponents and scientific notation. **Material Fee:** \$5 **Instructor:** Joanna Jimenez

Algebra 2 (Grades 9-12) #410031

Students will advance their skills through topics such as matrices, matrix multiplication, determinants, Cramer's rule, special and synthetic polynomials, solving quadratic equations by factoring, completing the square, and solving quadratic inequalities, using the quadratic formula, graphing quadratic equations, radicals, imaginary numbers,

complex numbers, logarithms, binomial theorem and more. This is a valuable class for those who wish to get ahead for the new school year or need to refresh their knowledge and skills. **Material Fee:** \$5 **Instructor:** Joanna Jimenez

Basketball Boot Camp (Grades 6-8) #650021

The dramatic increase in the state's foster care population has been attributed to many factors--there are a greater number of children living in poverty, increasing numbers of parents who abuse alcohol and drugs, and increasing cases of child abuse and neglect. The El Camino College Foster & Kinship Care Education program plays a vital role in providing licensed foster parents and relative caregivers with the training and education that will help them in meeting the multifaceted and often complex needs of the foster children in their care. El Camino College and other community colleges play an important role by providing over 25,000 hours of education/training to foster parents and relative caregivers.

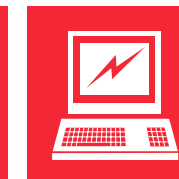

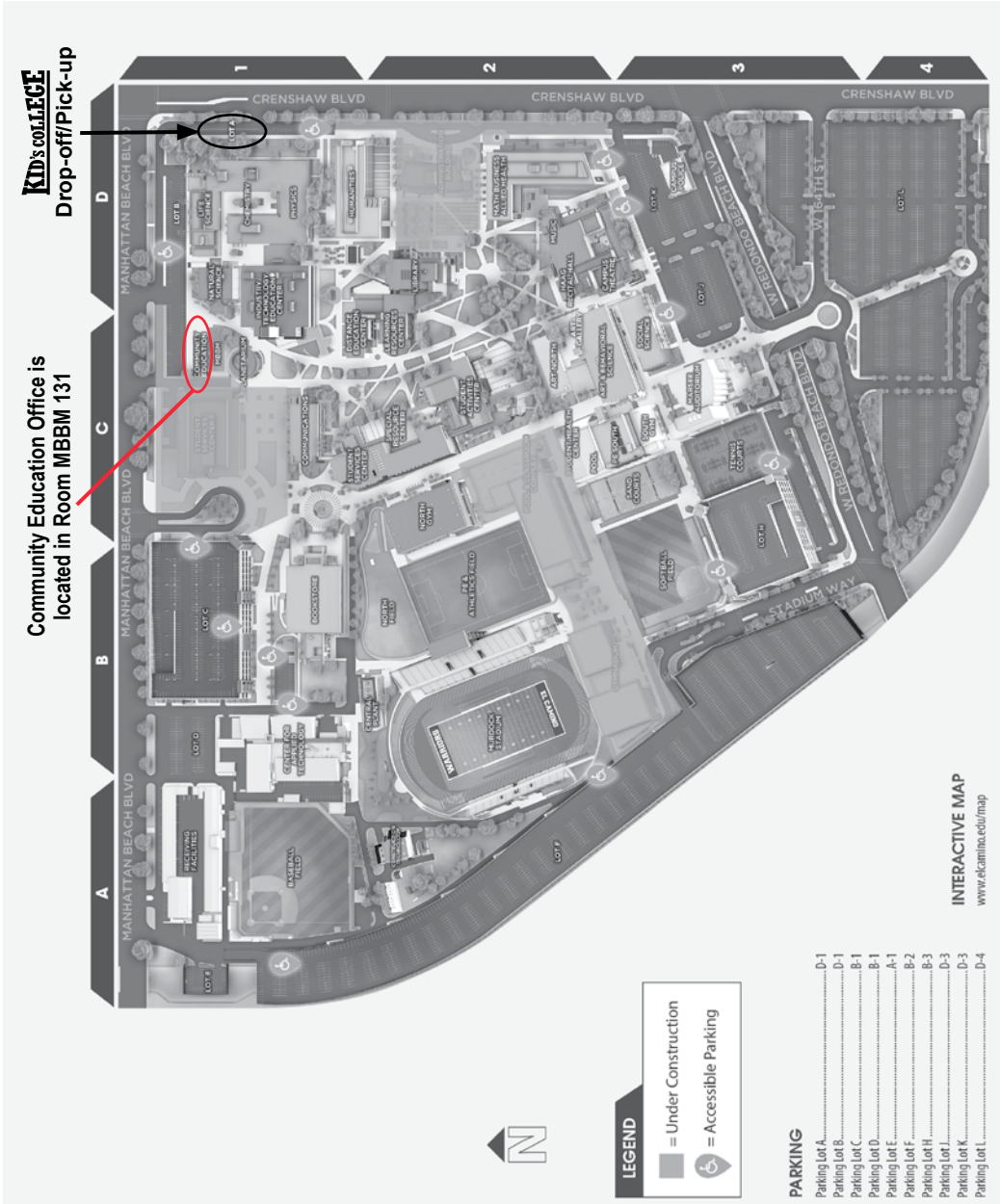

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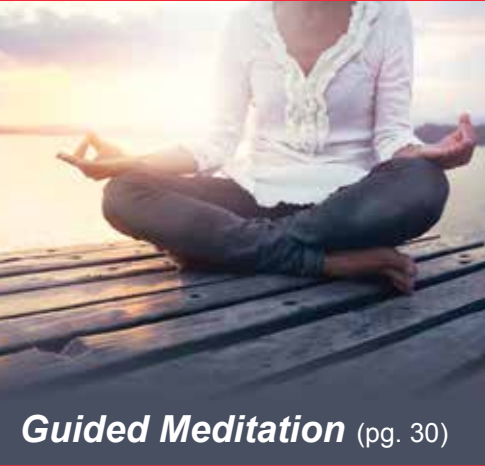
