

# INSTRUCTIONS SHEET

## VOCABULARY OF REAL ESTATE TEST

You are to complete the open-book, take-home, vocabulary test according to the list below, depending on the first letter your FIRST name, according to the official school roster for this class:

FIRST name starting with	A - C	=	midterm	<b>A</b>

“	“		M - O	= midterm <b>C</b>
“	“		P - Z	= midterm <b>D</b>

Prior students indicate that you should allocate about **4 hours** to complete this assignment. The easy way to do this is to take a few minutes each week, after class, and locate the terms you just learned. This installment method makes the big task seem smaller. Of course, there is always the old, standard college procedure: Begin it the night before it is due, beg friends for last minute answers--then show up late for class on the date due, because you are in the hall outside the door completing the assignment that you've had weeks to do.

Your answers must be placed on ONE Form 882 green scantron scoring sheet, marked with a #2 pencil. For NAME, PRINT your first and last name; For SUBJECT, write RE11 PRIN; For TEST NO, write MID A or MID B or MID C or MID D (your test LETTER); For DATE, write the DAY of your class (Online, Tu/Th, Mon, Tue, Wed, Thur, M/W); For HOUR, write your class meets (AM or PM or ONLINE). Not following directions is a reduction of 10 points from the 100 possible points.

Below is a sample of how to take the test. No answer is used twice. Every answer is used **ONLY** once. Note that there is only **ONE** right/correct answer. Read the definition column first to see if you can determine what word matches the choice. Mark as follows:

1. Dog	a. Home
2. Tree	b. Barks
3. Hair	c. Wood
4. Chair	d. Opens
5. Door	a. Bath, swim or drink it
6. House	b. Drive, park, or ride in
