Cancellations

Refunds

The refunds, if applicable, will be based upon the provided cancellation schedule. No refunds will be made for any components such as meals, accommodation and other items resulting from the participant’s absence or other situations that may make the participant not utilize such services.

Deviations

In general it is possible to deviate from the itinerary. A deviation fee in the amount of \$100 PLUS the cost of the change will apply (subject to availability and routing). Deviation requests have to be submitted in writing. Please be aware that once a deviation has been processed, any further deviation will cost an additional \$100. The deviation request deadline for this program is November 20, 2009. No deviations will be processed past this deadline.

Non-usage of Airfare

The participant may request to arrange for his/her own airfare and be reimbursed by LeonardoWorld LLC for non-usage of airfare. Please call LeonardoWorld LLC for the specific deduction amount. Please be advised that LeonardoWorld LLC does not provide additional airport transportation for participants who do not fly with the group. LeonardoWorld LLC does also not compensate the participant who misses out on included items due to his/her different flight schedule. The non-usage of airfare request deadline is November 10, 2009. Requests past this deadline will result in penalties, which will reduce the original deduction amount.

Passport and Other Travel Documents

U.S. and non-U.S. citizens are required to possess a valid passport for travel destinations. U.S. citizens and non-U.S. citizens participating in this program are requested to check detailed visa information. It is the sole responsibility of each participant to possess the appropriate documentation necessary to enter the countries on their itinerary. LeonardoWorld LLC is not responsible for participants obtaining passports and visas. LeonardoWorld LLC is not responsible for any of the participant’s expenses, cancellations and/or losses related to the participant not possessing the appropriate passport and visa documentation. with

BAGGAGE
