The Foundation helps ensure that all El Camino College students, regardless of their financial situation or background, have the support they need to achieve the American dream through a degree or certificate from our institution.





The College offers 94 degrees and 87 certificates taught by 1,150 full- and part-time faculty. As the world becomes more dependent on technology, we offer the best in science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) education through programs in engineering, physics, manufacturing technology, healthcare, computer information systems and more.

Students who can afford to enroll fulltime are more likely to complete their degree in two years, saving time and a significant amount of money over their lifetimes. The Foundation distributes \$1.4 million in scholarships annually allowing students to focus on their studies.
