Students Should

- Work quietly so other students are not disturbed.

- Turn off or silence all cell phones and pagers.

- Notify Library Media Technology Center (LMTC Computer Commons) staff immediately of any computer problems.

Students Should NOT

- Bring "guests" (i.e., friends, relatives, non-El Camino College guests) to the Library Media Technology Center (LMTC Computer Commons).
- Change settings on the computers.
- Attempt to fix any computer problems.
- Turn off the computer (CPU) upon leaving.
- Connect any external equipment or laptops into the El Camino College network.

Failure To Follow The Rules

- After two warnings (one verbal, one written), failure to abide by the rules will result in your being suspended from the lab.
- The Library Media Technology Center (LMTC Computer Commons) reserves the right to suspend a student without warning if the disruption is significant.
