SPECIAL CRIME ALERT BULLETIN

On Friday September 5, 2008 at approximately 6:45pm, a female student was walking alone to her vehicle in the Lot F Lower parking structure (Redondo Beach Blvd side), as she arrived at her vehicle and unknown person approached her from behind. The suspect then placed their left hand across victim's mouth and with the other hand begun to touch the victim's left inner thigh. The victim then elbowed the suspect and started to scream, at which time the suspect released the victim and fled the scene in an unknown direction. At this time the victim is unable to provide a full description of the suspect.

Suspect Description:

- Unknown sex, race, height or weight
- Possibly wearing gray sweat pants, and white Nike shoes
- Hands had the strong odor of a tobacco product

- If you have to walk alone at night, utilize the Campus Courtesy Shuttle (The shuttle operates 5:30 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Use one of the Blue POLICE poles located throughout campus, ask your instructor to call campus police for you, or call campus police on your own, 310-660-3100 to request the service)
- Always cooperate with the suspect's demands; your property can always be replaced
- Be prepared
