SPECIAL CRIME ALERT BULLETIN

On Friday May 23, 2008 at about 5:50 P.M. a female student was confronted by two unknown male subjects outside the east entrance to the Women's PE Complex. One of the suspects threatened the student if she did not comply with his instructions.

Suspects 1 and 2 walked the student inside the Women's PE Complex. While inside the Women's PE Complex, suspect #2 served as a look out while suspect #1 sexually assaulted the student. Suspects 1 and 2 then left the Women's PE Complex in an unknown direction.

Suspect #1 Description (Pictured):

- Male black adult, approximately 18-22 years, dark complexion
- Approximately 5'5", medium build, short black hair(Fade cut), clean shaven
- Crooked teeth, acne above his left eye brow
- Wearing a white t-shirt and blue jeans, large imitation round diamond earring in left ear lobe

Suspect #2 Description:

- Male black adult, approximately 18-22 years old, light complexion
- black hair(Fade cut),
- Wearing blue jeans, thick "Rolex" chain about mid to lower chest length
