In order to remain eligible for EOPS you **MUST** make at least 3 contacts each semester. At least 2 contacts **MUST** be with an EOPS Counselor. Not completing EOPS requirements will result in being placed on warning status with the program and/or dismissal.



### Educational Planning Contact

- Update a current educational plan each semester with an EOPS Counselor. If you have an updated educational plan from another department, an EOPS counselor needs to review it.

*Recommended Deadline:*

**Monday, Oct. 8<sup>th</sup>**



### Mid Semester Check-In Contact

- Meet with an EOPS Counselor or Advisor to discuss progress in reaching educational goals for the term and to review resources to enhance student success.

*Recommended Deadline:*

**Monday, Nov. 5<sup>th</sup>**



### Follow-up Planning Contact

- The purpose of this contact is to help you prepare for the next term or to make future plans if you are graduating, receiving a certificate, or transferring.

*Recommended Deadline:*

**Monday, Nov. 26<sup>th</sup>**

### Progress Reports due by Nov 1<sup>st</sup>\*

Progress reports are to be picked up at the EOPS Counseling Office beginning October 1st and must be turned in by November 1st. Progress reports may be dropped off at the front counter, however **this will not count as a contact unless you speak directly to an EOPS Counselor or Advisor.** Must discuss any substandard progress reports (grades below a "C" or NP) with an EOPS Counselor by November 15th before the "W" deadline.

\*For students enrolled in second eight week classes, you must turn in your progress reports by November 15th.
