

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN MARYMOUNT CALIFORNIA UNIVERSITY AND EL CAMINO COLLEGE



This agreement has been developed to facilitate the successful transfer of students from El Camino College to Marymount California University (MCU) in Rancho Palos Verdes. MCU accepts up to 90 units of transfer credit that may be applied to any Bachelor's degree. Only grades of C or higher are accepted. Completion of all of these courses is not required for admission however, they will allow for the most efficient time to degree completion and room to complete a minor, internship or begin our MBA.
