<u>UC APPLICATION UPDATE</u>: If you applied for Fall 2020, you must provide the UC with a list of courses completed in Fall 2019 and associated grades, as well as your planned coursework through Summer 2020. Even if you do not have any inprogress or planned courses and your record of course grades was complete in your original application, you must <u>log in to</u> your application and complete the Transfer Academic Update by **Jan. 31, 2020.**

<u>CSU APPLICATION UPDATE</u>: Transfer Applicants need to update transfer coursework on the Cal State Apply application in January 2020 so that Fall 2019 grades and Winter/Spring 2020 course enrollment can be added.

The following CSU's require Fall 2020 transfer applicants to submit a supplemental application:

- <u>CSULB:</u> The Supplemental Application is due between January 4 February 1, 2020.
 Students can fill out the application by going to the following website and clicking on the link that is titled: <u>Complete the</u> <u>Supplemental Application for Transfer Applicants</u>. <u>http://www.csulb.edu/admissions/supplemental-application</u>
- SDSU: The supplemental application is available in your SDSU WebPortal Account, and the application and tutorial will be available in early January 2020. The deadline to submit is January 22, 2020. https://sunspot.sdsu.edu/pls/webapp/web_menu.login/
- SJSU: The supplemental application will be assigned in MySJSU to transfer applicants during early January. Transfer applicants will have until January 30, 2020 to submit the supplemental application. http://www.sjsu.edu/admissions/impaction/supplementalapp/index.html
- <u>Cal Poly SLO:</u> The supplemental application will be available on your MyCalPoly portal in January. Applicants to Art, Music, and Architecture majors will need to submit the supplemental application by January 15, 2020. Applicants to all other majors will need to submit the supplemental application by January 31, 2020.

USC UPDATE: Students interested in applying to USC for admission to the 2020-2021 academic year are required to submit the Common Application and the USC Writing Supplement, both of which can be accessed at: **www.commonapp.org**
