## FALL 2019 TRANSFER ADMISSION GUARANTEE

### AM I ELIGIBLE FOR A TAG?

\_\_You must meet the definition of a California Community College (CCC) student

- You have been enrolled at one or more CCC's for at least 2 regular terms (excludes summer sessions)
- You are attending a CCC as your last college before transfer (excludes summer sessions) and in good standing

\_\_You must meet the following unit requirements for fall 2019 admission:

- Complete 60 semester (90 quarter) UC-transferable units
  - By the end of summer 2018: Complete 30 semester (45 quarter) UC-transferable units (may include AP/IB units)
  - By the end of spring 2019: Complete 30 semester (45 quarter) UC-transferable units at one or more CCC's

\_\_You must complete the following 7-course pattern by the end of spring 2019 for fall 2019 admission, earning a grade of "C" or better in each course:

- Two UC-transferable English Composition courses
- One UC-transferable Math course
- Four UC-transferable courses from two of the following three areas: Arts/Humanities, Social/Behavioral Sciences and Physical/Biological Sciences

### HOW DO I APPLY FOR A UCD TAG?

\_\_Use the UC Transfer Admission Planner (TAP) at (<https://uctap.universityofcalifornia.edu>) to complete the online UC TAG application and self-report your full academic history from all colleges/universities you have attended

\_\_Submit an online UC TAG application between **September 1-30, 2018** (you can only apply for a TAG at **one** UC campus)

\_\_Submit a UC admission application to UCD at ([www.universityofcalifornia.edu/apply](http://www.universityofcalifornia.edu/apply)) between **November 1-30, 2018** **(for the same major as the TAG application)**

### LIMITATIONS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

\_\_If you have taken any courses at a four-year university, you may not reach or exceed 80 semester (120 quarter) units of combined CCC lower division and four-year upper division units

\_\_The College of Engineering will consider applicants who have 80 or more semester units of combined CCC and non-CCC coursework

\_\_You must be enrolled at a CCC full-time for spring 2018, fall 2018 and spring 2019 prior to enrolling at UCD, though part-time enrollment may be allowed for good cause and with a brief explanation on the UC TAG application

\_\_TAG's are not acceptable for former UCD students who were regularly enrolled (excludes UCD summer session)

\_\_TAG is available to International students with domestic and international coursework, as well as AB540 students
