Month Important Information

February

- Meet with EOPS Counselor to complete educational planning contact
- Complete 1st CARE contact for services*
(EOPS/CARE eligibility must be established first)
- Last day to add a full semester class / drop without notation, **Feb 23rd**

March

- FAFSA and CA Dream Act application priority deadline, **March 2nd**
- Last day to apply for graduation and certificates, **March 2nd**
- Pick up progress reports **March 19th** and turn in by **April 19th**
- Complete 2nd CARE contact for services*
- Mini-Conference, **March 23rd**

April

- Spring Break, **April 7th – 13th**
- Last Day to turn in EOPS/CARE progress report, **April 19th**
- MID-TERMS, **April 2nd – 6th**

May

- Complete last EOPS Counseling contact
- Complete 3rd CARE contact for services*
- Last day to drop with a "W", **May 11th**
- Check MyECC for Summer and Fall 2018 registration appointment times

June

- Finals Weeks, **June 4th – 8th**

- Last day to complete EOPS and CARE contacts, **June 8th**

Three (3) times a semester, you are required to meet with the CARE advisor to receive CARE transportation assistance. While meeting with the CARE advisor, feel free to talk about any academic, family, and/or personal issues affecting your education.

*CARE services can only be picked up AFTER completing EOPS contacts. Only one transportation card per CARE contact. Only one CARE contact can be completed per day.

Harriett Buhai Center for Family Law

FREE legal services from Cheryl Segal (staff attorney) can assist you with custody, restraining orders, divorce, paternity, visitation, child support, alimony, and domestic violence. Appointments must be scheduled beforehand.



Grants

In addition to the EOPS Grant or Book Voucher, CARE students also may receive a CARE Grant worth up to \$750 for Spring 2018. No additional paper work is required to receive the grant but students must have met the Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements. Contact CARE Office for disbursement date.

TLC Program Torrance Memorial Medical Center

This program provides child care for sick children under the age of 13, for students attending class. To use this program, you must have an application on file before dropping your children off at the facilities. You may pick up more information and the application in the CARE office. This service is FREE for all CARE students.
