Torrance Loves Children is a hospital-based, sick-child care program licensed by the Department of Social Services. The program is for children of all ages, who are too ill to attend regular daycare or school.

At Torrance Loves Children, children receive plenty of TLC from Torrance Memorial's Pediatric Nursing Team. Children are able to:

- Play (quietly)
- Watch videos
- Work on arts and crafts projects
- Rest as needed

The program follows strict infection control protocols, children who have been recently exposed to communicable diseases, such as chicken pox, measles or mumps, or who exhibit symptoms of these diseases, cannot be accepted. Medical attention can be obtained quickly in case of an emergency.

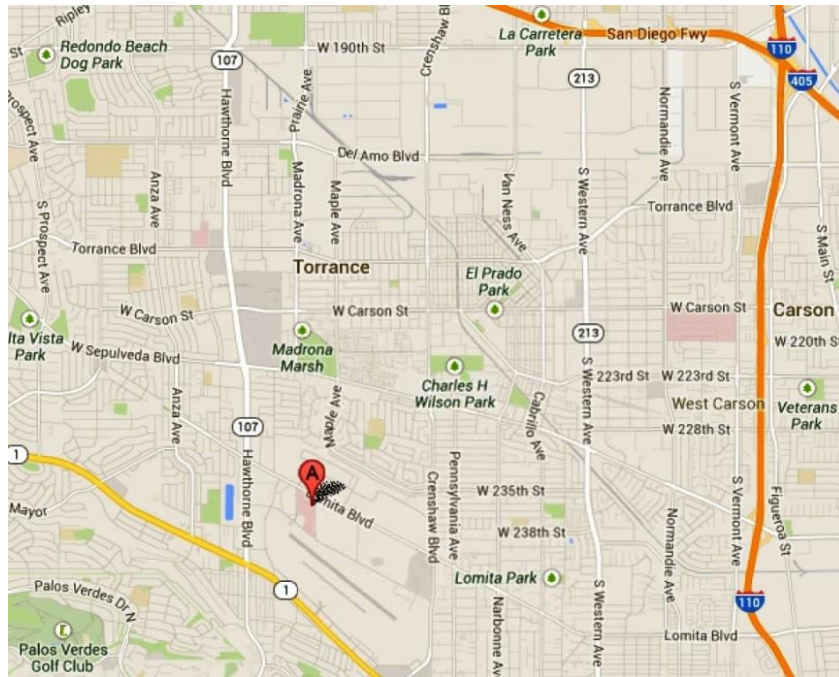
- Supervised by Pediatric nursing staff

- **Since space is limited there is a requirement to call two-hours before bringing the sick child to the Hospital.**
- Only \$4 per hour (plus \$1.50 per meal) – **FREE for ECC CARE students**
- Children up to the age of 13 are eligible
- Pre-Registration is **required!**
