HELPING YOU ACHIEVE YOUR EDUCATIONAL GOALS

At El Camino College we want every student to be successful; therefore, it is important that you follow the steps provided below:

Probation Level 1

The units or grades you complete in the current semester may not be enough to return you to good standing.

This means that you will be on level 2 if that occurs. This is why we strongly recommend that you attend an SEP workshop before your registration date.

Probation Level 2

It is mandatory that you attend a Student Enhancement Program (SEP) workshop BEFORE you register, add classes, or drop classes.

In other words, your ability to register will be totally blocked.

Attending the workshop will allow you to complete the probation contract and an educational plan which is needed to clear registration holds for probation level 2.

DEADLINE FOR SCHEDULING WORKSHOP:

Schedule before April 17th to prevent a delay in your registration.

Students who did not attend ECC for a semester or longer:

You must also re-apply for admissions for Fall 2014 by submitting an online "Application for Admission" at www.elcamino.edu. Click on the orange tab labeled "TO APPLY – START HERE." This is required to activate your returning student registration so that you can register after the probation hold is released. Re-apply as soon as possible in order to receive an appointment date.

How to schedule a workshop or counseling appointment

Please go to your MyECC account under "WebAdvisor" click on "Online Counseling Appointments." Appointments can be scheduled beginning Friday after 5:00 pm. Appointment Help Desk hours: Mondays from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. 310-660-3458.

Bring a pen or pencil and your unofficial ECC transcripts to the workshop. You can print the transcripts by logging on to MyECC.

If you have attended an SEP workshop within a year:

Please schedule an appointment with a counselor to update your educational plan and probation level 2 contract before your registration date.

EFFECTIVE SUMMER 2014:

Students on probation for a second semester will be ineligible for priority registration.
