

SECTION B: MAJOR REQUIREMENTS (SELECT 1 OR 2)

1. Complete the set of courses specified after the heading, "El Camino College Major Requirements" in one major field section shown in the El Camino College catalog.
2. *Complete the set of courses specified for an accredited four-year institution by selecting one of the following options:
 - a. Complete courses equivalent to those shown as requirements in the transfer institution catalog, insofar as such courses are offered at El Camino College.
 - b. Complete transfer major requirements on the guide sheets in the counseling division.

***If the courses in preparation for the major at the transfer institution do not total a minimum of 18 units, students must complete the El Camino College major in their field of interest and will be granted the Associate degree in the El Camino College major or students may choose to complete the Transfer Studies Major (refer to the college catalog for additional information on this major).**

SECTION C: ELECTIVES

El Camino College Major: Electives are courses used to reach the total of 60 degree applicable units. If requirements A and B do not total 60 units, then additional units from A and/or B or other degree applicable courses should be taken to bring the total up to 60 units. Students may count up to 6 units of physical education as elective credit for graduation.

Transfer Major: If requirements A and B do not total 60 units, then additional units from A and/or B or other degree applicable courses should be taken to bring the total up to 60 units. (Students who decide to transfer to a CSU or UC, electives must be chosen from transferable courses. Students may only count 4 PE units for the UC and 6 PE units for CSU as transfer credit).

RESIDENCE REQUIREMENT: A minimum of 12 degree applicable units must be successfully completed at El Camino College to receive the Associate Degree.

SECOND DEGREE: Students may receive both an Associate in Arts and an Associate in Science Degree upon completion of the specific general education and major requirements for each degree as stated in the catalog.

GRADUATION: Students must file intent to graduate in the Admissions Office by the deadline published in the schedule of classes. Students planning to graduate from ECC should have official transcripts from other colleges attended sent directly to the Admissions/Records Office and meet with an academic counselor at ECC to ensure all requirements have been met before filing for graduation. Students who have maintained continuous enrollment may choose to graduate under the catalog requirements in effect 1) at the time enrollment began at El Camino College or 2) in effect at the time of graduation from El Camino College. Continuous enrollment is defined as enrollment at El Camino College at least one semester (fall or spring), excluding summer and winter session, each academic year; courses must be noted on the transcript with a letter grade, a W, or a CR/NC designation on the transcript. For further information, consult with an ECC academic counselor. Students who choose the Transfer Studies Major should indicate one degree, either the AA or AS, on the graduation petition.
