

ANTIOCH UNIVERSITY LOS ANGELES and EL CAMINO COLLEGE <u>Articulation Agreement</u> General Studies Transfer Equivalents Effective beginning the Academic Year 2009-2010

Antioch University Los Angeles (AULA) welcomes applications from transfer students who have a minimum of 20 or more transferable semester units, although we suggest students complete 30 or more transferable semester units. While we encourage students to take courses in a variety of subject areas that promote strong writing and critical thinking skills, Antioch does not require students to complete their general studies in order to transfer.

Students should be aware that a minimum of 180 quarter units (120 semester units), including 90 quarter units (60 semester units) of upper division are required for graduation from Antioch, and the final 48 quarter units must be taken in residence at AULA. In order for the course to be accepted as transferable, a grade of "C-" or better must be achieved.

Antioch does recommend that students begin completing some of their general studies as part of their 20 or more transferable semester units. For additional counsel on these and other requirements, students and counselors should feel free to contact the AULA Admissions Office at any point in their program.

## Courses transferable to Antioch University Los Angeles General Studies requirements

At least 6 quarter units (4 semester units) in each of the following six <u>Domains of</u> <u>Knowledge</u> are required in order to fulfill the distribution component of Antioch's General Studies requirement. Thus, if you took 1 course worth three semester units in one Domain, you would still need additional units to fulfill that area. Courses within a student's Area of Concentration (which is like a "major") may not also be used to complete a Domain.
