Fisk University will accept courses from the IGETC (Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum) pattern as part of their general education core. If students obtain an Associate degree they may be exemption from the entire Fisk Core (general education) curriculum.

1. English Communication One course in English composition and one course in critical thinking/ English composition.	2 courses	7 semester units
2. Mathematical Concepts and Quantitative Reasoning	1 course	3 semester units
3. Arts and Humanities Three course with at least one from Humanities.	3 courses	9 semester units
4. Social and Behavioral Sciences Three courses from at least two disciplines .	3 courses	9 semester units
5. Physical and Biological Sciences One physical science course and one biological science course, at least one of which contains a lab.	2 courses	7 semester units
6. Language other than English Foreign language equivalent to the third semester of the same language. Students pursuing a degree in Physics are exempt from foreign language.	Proficiency	Proficiency
