CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

The study of history can help students gain perspective on their own society and compare its traditions with those of other civilizations. Average employment prospects are expected for historians who have a master's or doctoral degrees and wish to work in teaching, libraries, archives, museums, research and editorial organizations, and government. Those possessing only a B.A. are likely to find very limited opportunities. A history major is a good background for lawyers, legislators, business executives, radio and television newscasters, and foreign service. This major may also lead to many other careers. *Note: History is an impacted major. To be admitted to the history major students must meet the following criteria: Complete History courses with a 2.20 GPA, a cumulative GPA of 2.40 and 60 transferable units.

UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, BERKELEY

History 3 or 4, 1A or 1B; Select one course from: History 14A or 14B or 19; Select one additional history course from the aforementioned list.

***Note:** Students must complete either IGETC or L&S requirements in reading and composition, foreign language, and quantitative reasoning by the end of the spring semester prior to fall enrollment at UCB. AP scores cannot be used to satisfy major requirements

UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, DAVIS

History 14A-14B; Select two from 1A, 1B, 18A, 18B

*Note: If students take History 14A and 14B, credit will be given for UCD's History 9A or 9B, not both

UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, IRVINE

Select two groups of courses from at least two different regions from the following:

Group/Region 1: History 1A and 1B **or** Group/Region 2: 12A and 12B **or**

Group/Region 3: 14A and 14B **or** Group/Region 4: History 3 and 4

Two years of a single foreign language (instruction through foreign language 4);

Select a up to 3 additional UC transferable history courses.

Complete at least one course from each area (literature requires the completion of two courses): Writing: English 1A, 1B, 1C; Literature: two courses from: English 10, 11, 12, 15A, 15B, 35, 36, 40A, 40B; Philosophy: Philosophy 2, 7, 10, 11, 23; History: History 1A, 1B, 3, 4, 22

UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, LOS ANGELES

History 3 or 4; Select two courses from: History 1A, 1B, 5A, 5B, 8, 9, 12A, 12B, 14A, 14B, 16A, 16B, 17, 18A, 18B, 19, 22, 25, 30, 32

UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, RIVERSIDE

History 3 or 4 or 22; Select two additional UC transferable history courses;
