Philosophy (6 semester hours):

Students are required to take PHIL 160: Philosophy of Human Nature at LMU and 3 semester hours of upper division philosophy to fulfill the core requirement.

Note: Transfer student who enters LMU with a minimum of sixty (60) accepted transfer hours are exempted from the lower division (PHIL 160) requirement.

Social Sciences (6 semester hours)

*Under Option C, the student is required to take an upper division course in the same department at Loyola Marymount University in order to fulfill the core requirement in Social Sciences.

Theological studies (6 semester hours)

Students will be required to take one lower division theology course and one upper division theology course.

Note: Transfer students who enter LMU with a minimum of sixty (60) accepted transfer hours are exempt from the lower division requirement.
