Literature (3 semester hours)

El Camino College students may choose one of the following:

English 1B, 10, 12, 23, 35, 36

Mathematics, Science and Technology (18 semester hours)

This requirement is met by the curriculum of the major in the College of Science and Engineering.

Philosophy (6 semester hours):

Students are required to take PHIL 160: Philosophy of Human Nature at LMU and 3 semester hours of upper division philosophy to fulfill the core requirement.

Note: Transfer students who enter LMU with a minimum of sixty (60) accepted transfer hours are exempted from the lower division (PHIL 160) requirement.

Social Sciences (6 semester hours)

El Camino College students choose one of the three following options A, B, or C:

** Not required for B.S. in Engineering (Civil, Electrical, Mechanical and Engineering Physics), this requirement is met by major curricula.

Option A:

Select 2 courses from the following departments (courses must be from different departments):

Anthropology 2	Economics 1, 2, 5	Geography 2
Political Science 1, 2	Psychology 5	Sociology 101

Option B:

Select: Women's Studies 1 **and**

One course from the following:

Anthropology 2	Economics 1, 2, 5	Geography 2
Political Science 1, 2	Psychology 5	Sociology 101

Option C:

Select one course from the following:

Anthropology 2	Economics 1, 2, 5	Geography 2
Political Science 1, 2	Psychology 5	Sociology 101

*Under Option C, the student is required to take an upper division course in the same department at Loyola Marymount University in order to fulfill the core requirement in Social Sciences.

Theological Studies (6 semester hours)

Students will be required to take one lower division theology course and one upper division theology course.

Note: Transfer students who enter LMU with a minimum of sixty (60) accepted transfer hours are exempt from the lower division requirement.
