Paralegal Studies Certificate of Competence

A Certificate of Achievement will be awarded to those possessing an Associate, Bachelor or higher degree or who will be completing a degree concurrently with the certificate requirements. Students may earn this certificate by completing the major course with a B average or better.

Other Requirements

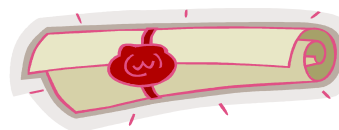
Prerequisites: Entrance to the program is gained by successful completion of Law 11, Introduction to Legal Research. The Prerequisite to Law 11 is eligibility for English 1A.

General Education Requirements: Associate Degree students must complete a minimum of 24 general education units. Of these 24 required units, 18 units must be approved by the American Bar Association. See reverse for ABA-approved courses. All students must meet with a counselor before beginning the Paralegal Studies program.

In Residence Requirements: A total of 15 units of Legal Specialty courses including Law 11, 17, 20 and six additional units selected from Law 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 18 or 19 must be taken at El Camino College for degree/certificate.

This program does not prepare students for law school or the practice of law. "No person shall practice law in this state unless he/she is an active member of the State Bar." Cal. Bus. & Prof. Code, Section 6125

Paralegals may not provide legal services directly to the public, except as permitted by law.
