A. Pre Transfer-Level Math

Placement into Pre Transfer-Level Math is based on your Arithmetic Test score or your Elementary Algebra Test score or both scores. Students scoring below 120 on the Arithmetic Test or below 30 on the Elementary Algebra Test will be placed in the appropriate class based on the Arithmetic Test score and the appropriate course offered at a specific campus.

B. Transfer-Level Math

Placement into Transfer-Level Math is based on your College-level Math Test score. Students scoring below 63 will be required to take the Elementary Algebra Test and recommended placement from that test will be used.
