#### AM LELIGIBLE FOR A TAG?

\_\_You must meet the definition of a California Community College (CCC) student

- You have been enrolled at one or more CCC's for at least 2 regular terms (excludes summer sessions)
- You are attending a CCC as your last college before transfer (excludes summer sessions) and in good standing
- \_\_You must meet the following unit requirements for fall 2018 admission:
  - Complete 60 semester (90 quarter) UC-transferable units
    - By the end of summer 2017: Complete 30 semester (45 quarter) UC-transferable units (may include AP/IB units)
    - By the end of spring 2018: Complete 30 semester (45 quarter) UC-transferable units at one or more CCC's

\_\_You must complete the following 7-course pattern by the end of spring 2018 for fall 2018 admission, earning a grade of "C" or better in each course:

- Two UC-transferable English Composition courses
- One UC-transferable Math course
- Four UC-transferable courses from two of the following three areas: Arts/Humanities, Social/Behavioral Sciences and Physical/Biological Sciences
