- ✓ Completing the FAFSA without the using exact date-of-birth **will keep you from getting paid.**
- ✓ Withdrawing from all classes **may cause you to repay/return financial aid money.**
- ✓ Failing to maintain satisfactory academic standards **will disqualify you for financial aid.**
- ✓ Missing deadlines **will cost you money.**
- ✓ Keeping a current address and telephone number on file in the Admissions Office and keeping accurate records **will save you money.**
