- Your Grade Point Average (GPA) is below 2.0.
- You completed less than 67% of your total attempted units.
- You completed less than 67% of term attempted units.
- You attempted 90 or more units for an AA/AS degree programs or 45 attempted units for a certificated program. Transfer units are included.
- You have earned a prior (AA/AS, BA/BS, or advanced) degree from any college including foreign colleges or universities.

You **must** submit an appeal to be considered for financial aid at El Camino College. Follow these steps to file an appeal:

1. Meet with an academic counselor to develop a year long educational plan (or a Lock-In-List if you have attempted more than 90 units). Call your campus Financial Aid Office to schedule an appointment.
2. Complete the 2010-2011 Satisfactory Academic Progress Questionnaire. It may be downloaded and printed at www.elcamino.edu/student-services/fao/forms1011.asp. The answers can be found on the financial aid website.
3. Submit your Financial Aid Disqualification Appeal, SAP Questionnaire, and Educational Plan (or Lock-in-List) to your campus Financial Aid Office, in advance of the deadline posted on our website.
4. The Appeals Committee will notify you via e-mail of their **final** decision.
