



Correct FAFSA

Financial Aid Application Rejected Corrective Action Needed Immediately!

The federal processor has rejected your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You must take the following steps to correct your application:

1. Read the comments on the first page of your Student Aid Report (SAR) to see why your application was rejected at www.fafsa.gov.
2. Make corrections online or by telephone.
 - a) Make corrections electronically online at www.fafsa.gov. Remember you and/or your parent(s) need a Personal Identification Number (PIN) to make corrections online.

OR

- b) Make corrections by telephone by contacting the Federal Student Aid Information Center at 1 (800) 433-3243. Remember to send the signature page to the processing center via U.S. mail.
3. Once you receive your revised Student Aid Report (SAR), review the results for accuracy.
4. Submit requested documents.
 - a) Log on to **MyECC** (1-2 weeks after receiving your valid SAR), and click on the "Communication" link under WebAdvisor to see the "My Documents" link. Review what forms/documents the Financial Aid Office is requesting from you.
 - b) Click the "Forms" link on the main Financial Aid Office Web page at <http://www.elcamino.edu/studentsevices/fao/> to download and print the forms.
 - c) Complete and submit all requested forms/documents to the Financial Aid Office immediately. Incomplete forms will not be accepted. Completed files are processed on a first-come, first-serve basis.
