



## FINANCIAL AID PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

In order to receive Title IV federal student financial assistance at El Camino College, a student must be enrolled in an eligible program for the purpose of completing an associate degree, transfer requirements, or a certificate program that requires a minimum of sixteen (16) units.

The list below indicates the programs that are considered INELIGIBLE. On the reverse side is a list of ELIGIBLE programs. Please be aware that although you may receive an award letter, if you have selected an ineligible program you will not receive a payment. Most ineligible programs are considered to be “stackable” which means that they build upon and lead to an eligible program. However, an eligible program must be chosen for financial aid eligibility.

If you wish to change your program, visit the Admissions & Records Office or the Counseling Office within the Student Services Center. It is highly recommended that you see an academic counselor before selecting a program.
