## CITIZEN AND ELIGIBLE NON-CITIZEN INFORMATION SHEET

To receive financial aid, federal law requires students be a U.S. citizen or an eligible non-citizen. **Bring in your original documents for verification.** The Financial Aid Office will photocopy the original document that you submit for your financial aid file. In some cases, the documentation you submit to El Camino College may be forwarded to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security for confirmation.
