The Academic Competitiveness Grant (ACG)

Who is eligible?

To receive the ACG each academic year, a student must:

Be a U.S. citizen

Be a Federal Pell Grant recipient

Be enrolled full-time in a degree program

Be enrolled in the first or second academic year of his or her program of student at a two-year or four-year degree-granting institution

Have completed a rigorous secondary school program of study (after January 1, 2006, if a first-year student, and after January 1, 2005, if a second-year student)? The financial Aid Office will need to verify that the student completed a rigorous program. The validation form is available on the Financial Aid Office website

If a first-year student, not have been previously enrolled in an undergraduate program

If a second-year student, have at least a cumulative 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale for the first academic year

How can I apply?

Apply for Financial Aid by submitting a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) www.fafsa.ed.gov

Pick up a rigorous course of study validation form from the Financial Aid Office

Submit the form to your high school for validation

When validation is complete, please return it to the Financial Aid Office
