BASIC FUNCTION:

Incumbents in these positions also check tools in and out to students and faculty, recommend new and replacement equipment, and purchase and keep an inventory on all necessary tools and equipment for their assigned areas. Work at this level requires substantial knowledge in the operation and repair of tools and equipment in the designated specialty area.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

Perform moderately complex repair and maintenance on tools and equipment.

Repair and maintenance of shop equipment such as automotive parts including brake lathes, VAT-40s, voltmeter leads, air tools, etc.

Repair and maintenance of electronic equipment used in classroom labs such as digital designers, multi-meters, power supplies, probes, etc.

Adjust, calibrate and assure proper operation of tools and equipment used in assigned area; and configure and/or repair computer hardware and install and upgrade various software programs.

Check out tools, equipment and supplies to students in an assigned area such as Automotive Technology, Auto Collision and Repair, Electronics or Machine Tools.

Operate specialized hand and power tools and equipment in accordance with health and safety regulations.

Collaborate with supervisor and provide input during budget preparation including making projections regarding tool and equipment needs for the year.

Recommend new and replacement tools and equipment as necessary and research which vendors offer the best products for the best price.

Set up labs for classroom work, assist students with operation of tools and equipment while in the lab, and monitor the labs for safety hazards.

Purchase all necessary supplies for assigned area and is responsible for organizing, preparing and keeping an inventory on all tool room equipment and supplies.
