

Outside Contractor Tests Positive for COVID-19

El Camino College was notified Tuesday, April 7 that an individual employed by one of the construction companies performing work on campus has tested positive for COVID-19. This individual was last on campus on Tuesday, March 31 and was not physically present anywhere on campus other than the closed construction zone. Additionally, the construction company confirms that the individual had no contact with any El Camino College students, faculty, or staff. We send this individual our best wishes for a quick recovery.
