One-time Investments:

- Online education infrastructure
- Expansion of apprenticeships

2021 Budget Proposal

- Ongoing adjustments: Enrollment growth and COLA, with updated estimates of revenue and enrollment
- Buy down of significant portion of 2020 revenue deferrals



- Establishment of a Social Justice Center under Student Development Office and ASO


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Recommendations:
