# Daniel G. Solórzano

Professor of Social Science and Comparative Education Professor of Chicana/o and Central American Studies Director of the Center for Critical Race Studies in Education University of California, Los Angeles

Daniel G. Solórzano is a Professor of *Social Science and Comparative Education and Chicana/o and Central American Studies* at the University of California, Los Angeles. He is also the Director of the *Center for Critical Race Studies in Education* at UCLA. His teaching and research interests include critical race theory in education; racial microaggressions; racial microaffirmations; and critical race spatial analysis. Dr. Solórzano has authored more than 100 research articles, book chapters, and books on issues related to educational access and equity for underrepresented student populations and communities in the United States. In 2007, Professor Solórzano received the *UCLA Distinguished Teaching Award*. In 2012, Solórzano was awarded the Critical Race Studies in Education Association *Derrick A. Bell Legacy Award*. In 2014, Solórzano was elected a *Fellow* of the American Education Research Association. Professor Solórzano received the *Distinguished Alumni Award* from the Claremont Graduate University in 2020. Also, in 2020, Solórzano was elected to the *National Academy of Education*.


Using the Critical Race Tools of Racial Microaggressions and Microaffirmations to Examine Everyday Racism in Academic and Social Spaces
