Instructions for Staff – Faculty - Students (Draft)

Due to COVID-19, the State of California has recommended a virtual earthquake drill

At 10:15 a.m., you will hear alert sounds from the Police vehicles throughout campus and receive information on your telephone. This sound simulates the beginning of a major earthquake. Do the following:

- 1. STAY CALM AND DUCK, COVER, AND HOLD ON UNTIL FUTHER NOTICE. Take refuge under a sturdy object.
- 2. After approximately one minute, the earthquake simulation will end and you are to SHELTER IN PLACE and stay where you are until you receive further notification.
- 3. Do Not Evacuate Your Area for the purpose of this **Virtual Drill**. SHELTER IN PLACE.
- 4. Please go to the link that was sent to you concerning the YouTube Earthquake Video.
- 5. It has been declared, All Clear. You may now resume your regularly scheduled activities.

End of Drill – Thank you for your participation in this important exercise. By participating, you will help us to get ready for <u>big earthquakes</u> and to prevent disasters from becoming catastrophes.
