Instructions for Staff – Faculty - Students (Draft)

****Due to COVID-19, the State of California has recommended a virtual earthquake drill****

At 10:15 a.m., you will hear alert sounds from the Police vehicles throughout campus and receive information on your telephone. This sound simulates the beginning of a major earthquake. Do the following:

1. STAY CALM AND DUCK, COVER, AND HOLD ON UNTIL FUTHER NOTICE. Take refuge under a sturdy object.
2. After approximately one minute, the earthquake simulation will end and you are to SHELTER IN PLACE and stay where you are until you receive further notification.
3. Do Not Evacuate Your Area for the purpose of this **Virtual Drill**. SHELTER IN PLACE.
4. Please go to the link that was sent to you concerning the YouTube Earthquake Video.
5. It has been declared, All Clear. You may now resume your regularly scheduled activities.

End of Drill – Thank you for your participation in this important exercise. By participating, you will help us to get ready for big earthquakes and to prevent disasters from becoming catastrophes.
