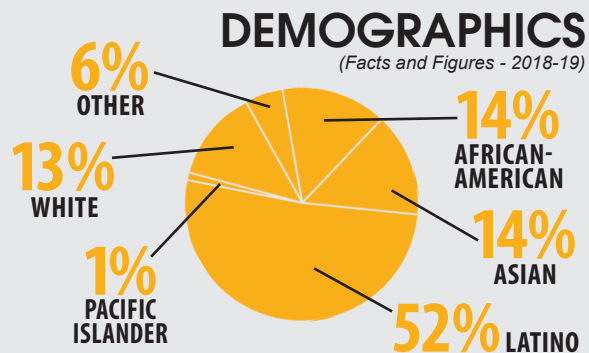
Program Highlights


