










5. Course Withdrawal (Decrease)

6. Employable Skill Attainment


Definition: Percent of students who successfully complete a Career Education course (SAM codes A, B, C, or D) designed to teach employable skills.



Number of students earning a degree.




8. Certificate Completion

Number of students earning a certificate.




9. Transfers to CSU or UC






