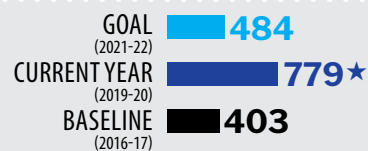

1B Increase students who earn a certificate by **20%**



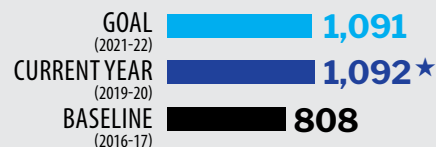

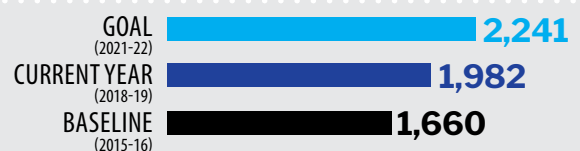
