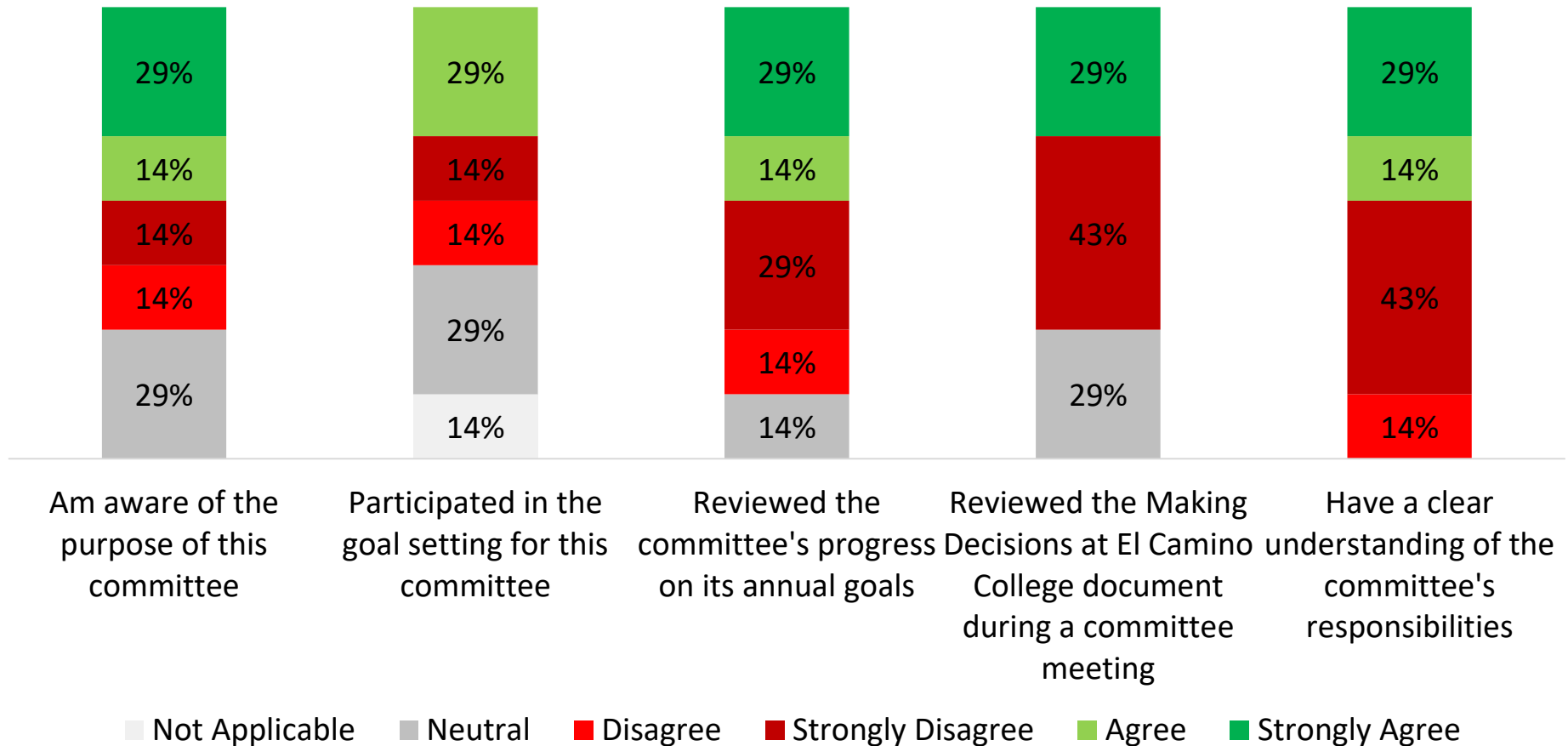

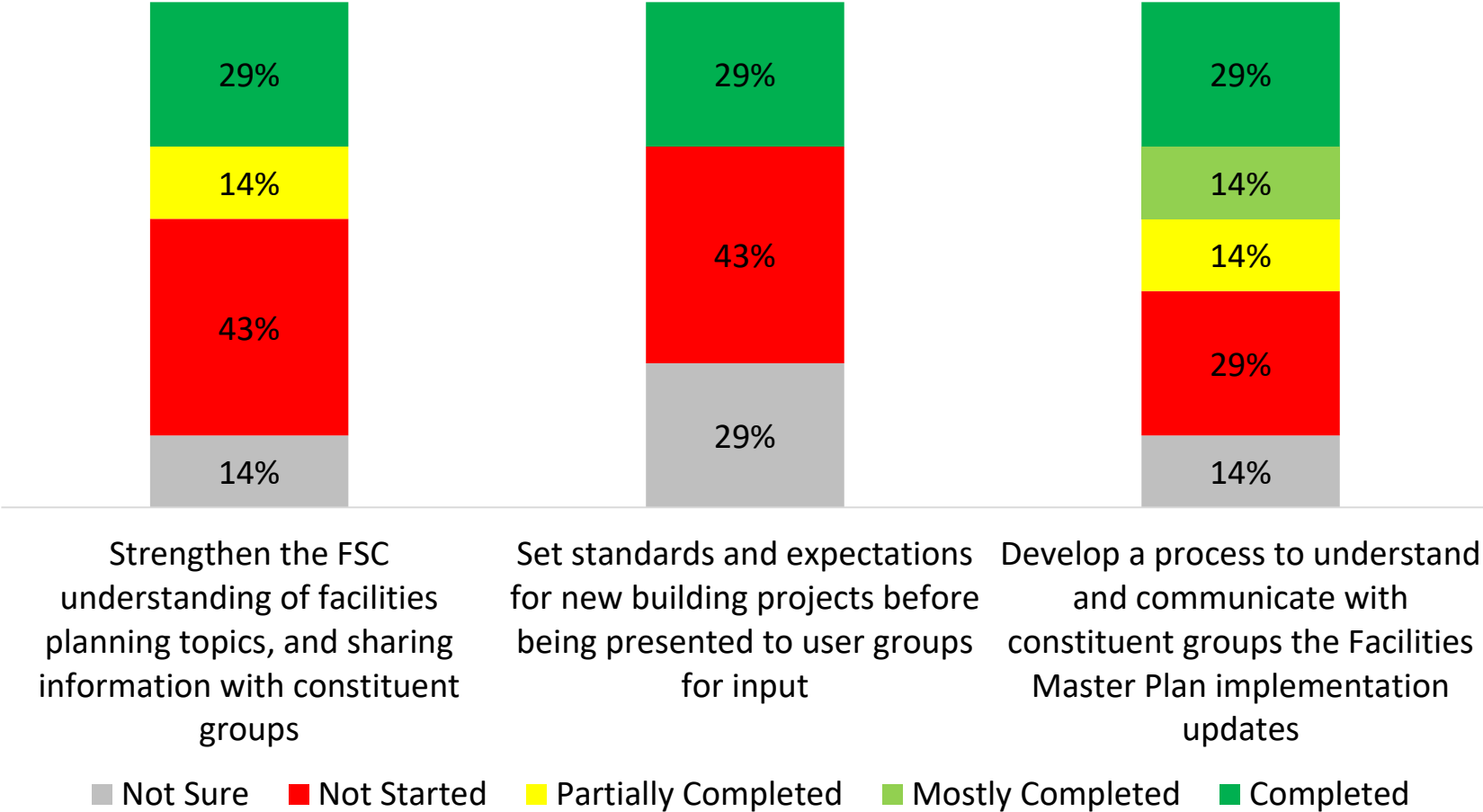

Response rate: 37% (7 out of 19)

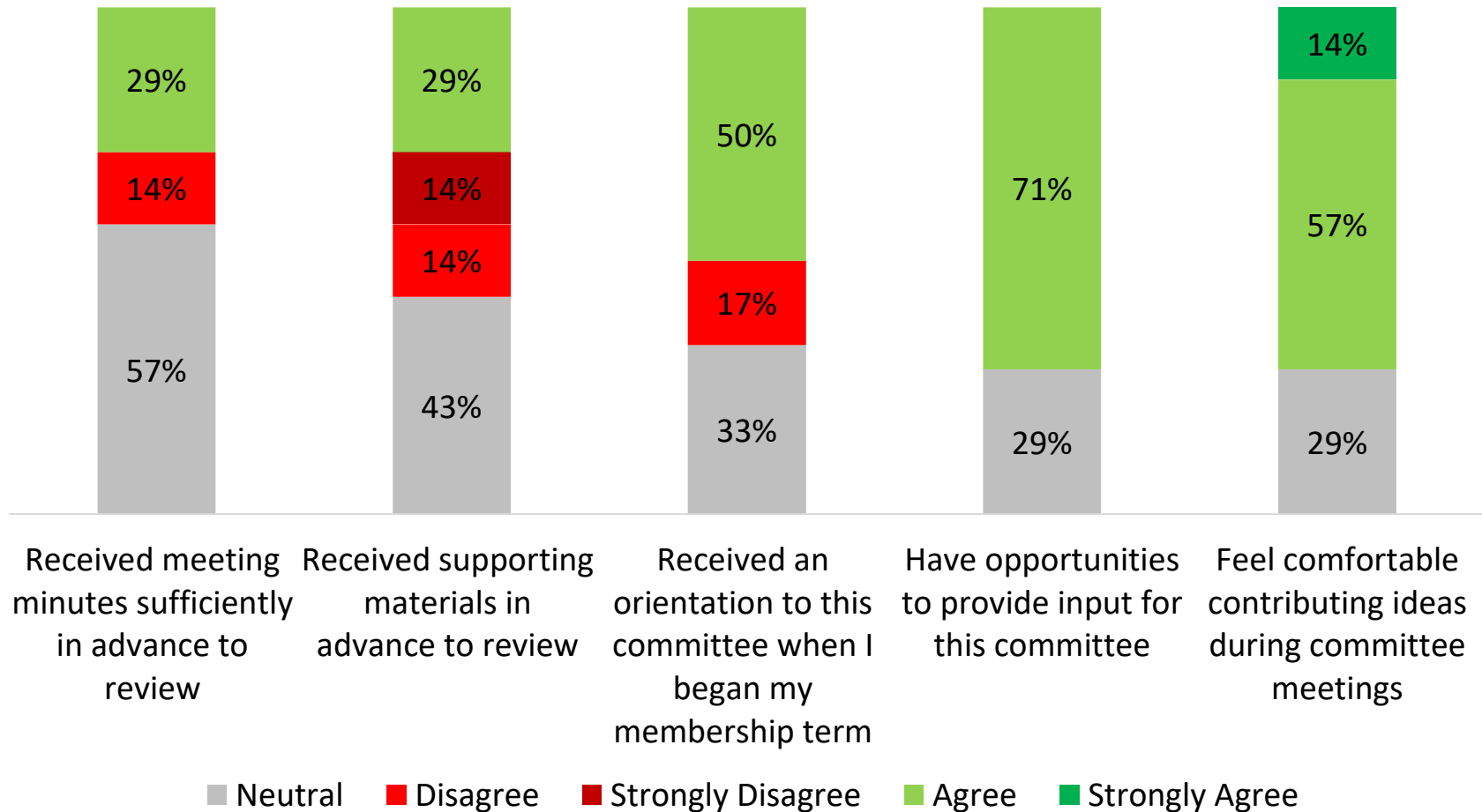
Findings for Purpose, Goals & Tasks



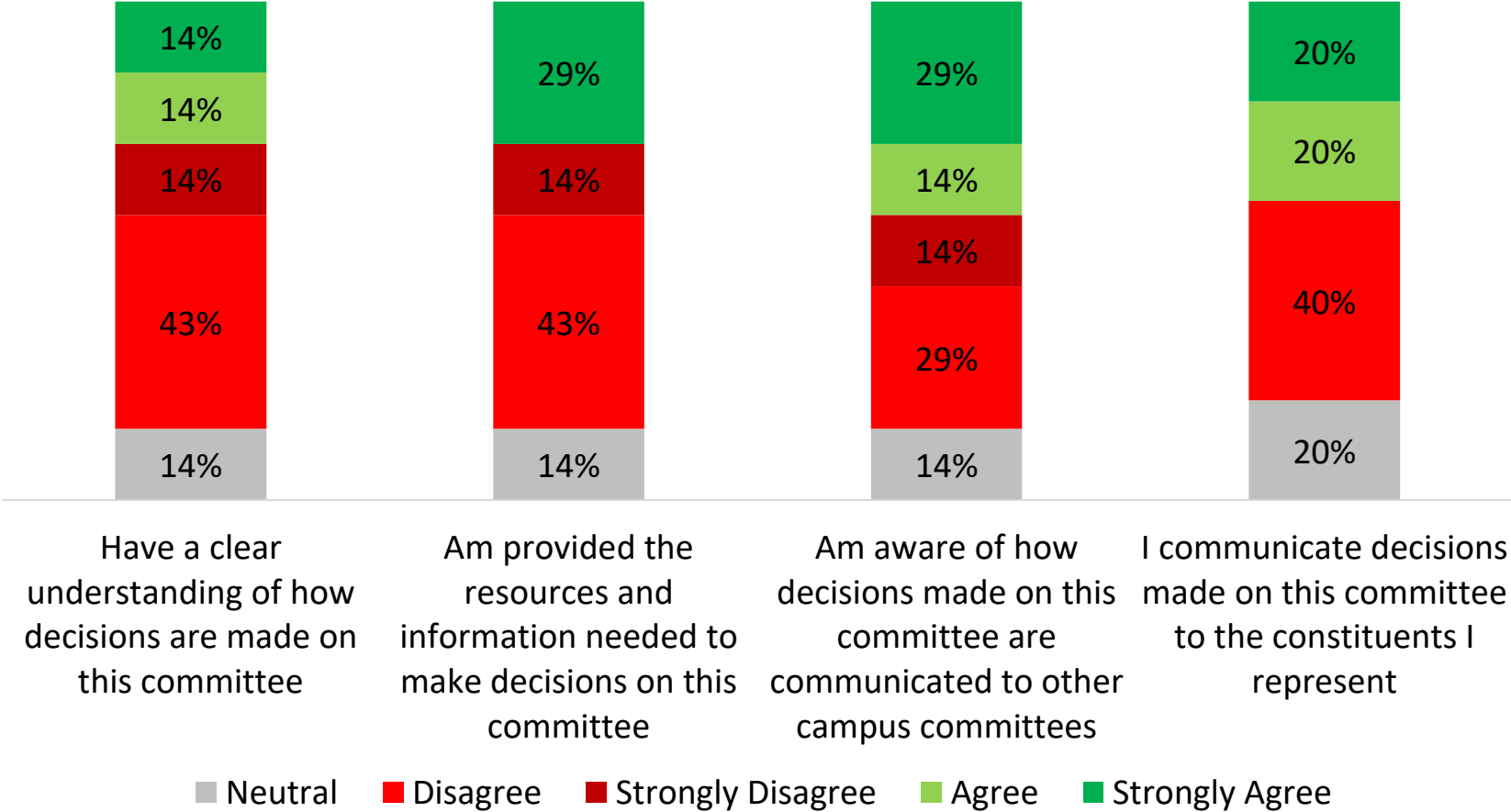
Findings for Completion of Goals

Accomplishments Mentioned by Respondents

- Not sure. Committee chair just reports on construction progress.
- I do not know.

Improvements Mentioned by Respondents

- More frequent meetings are needed.
- The FSC should not only be a reporting committee.
- Information is shared but committee's input is not sought.
- Establish a process by which Facilities major decisions are made considering the committee's input. (e.g.: The Facilities plan consultant was hired without consultation; plan was developed without any meaningful input from any ECC constituents. The plan was shared after it was developed by consultant. It is unclear that the College constituencies want what is proposed in the plan).
- A clear understanding of why this committee exists is needed.
- Increase understanding of the reason why only bond items are discussed in committee meetings.
- In addition to bond items, include other Facilities topics in agenda meetings.
- Prior minutes and agendas need to be updated in the committee's website.
- Communication and direction are needed.
