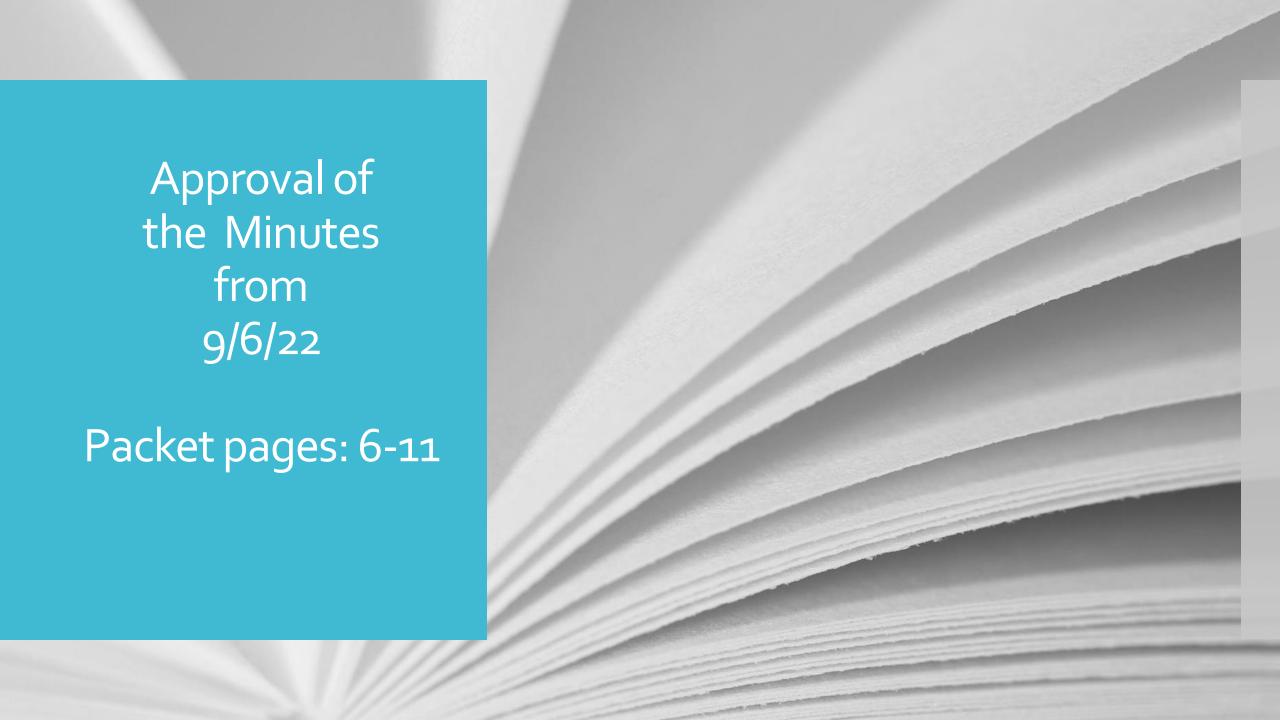


Quick Reminder

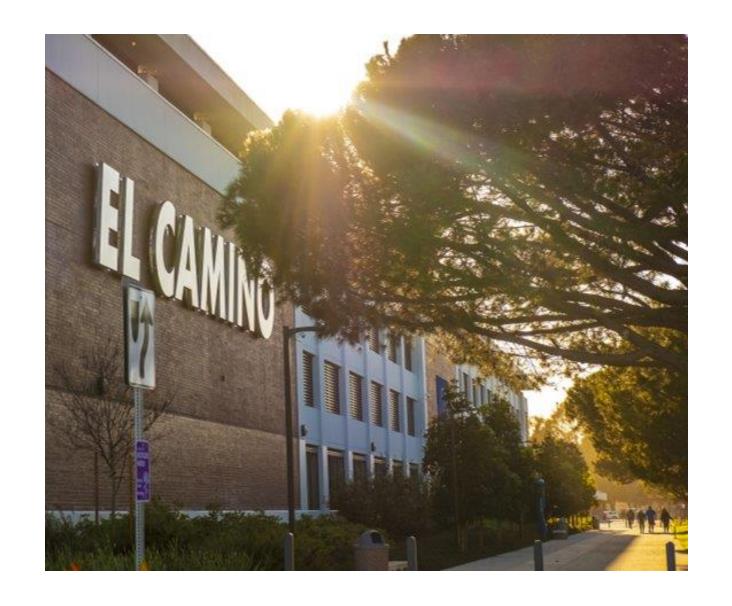
