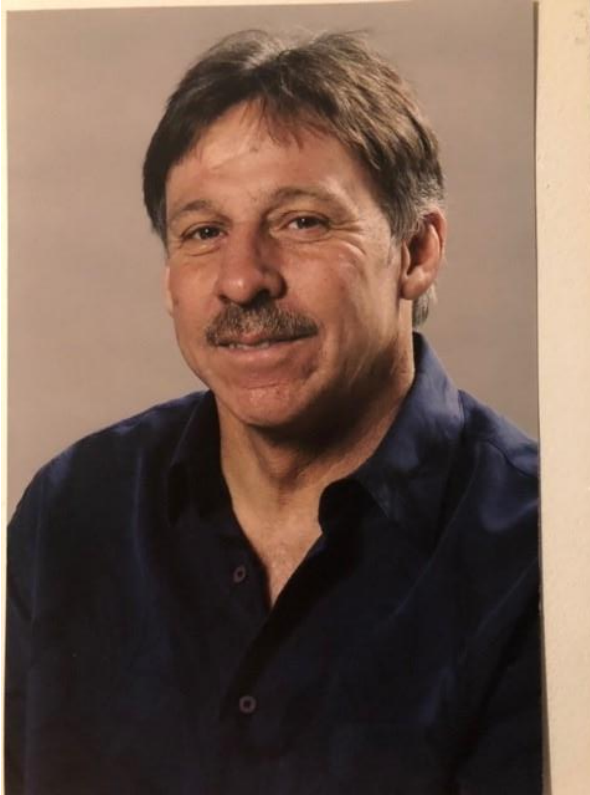

# SOAA—Scale of Adoption Assessment (Guided Pathways)

- Four areas based on the four pillars
  - Mapping Pathways to student end goals (Clarify the Path), pgs. 3-11
  - Helping Students Choose and Enter a Program Pathway (Enter the Path), pgs. 12-31
  - Keeping Students on the Path (Stay on the Path), pgs. 32-39
  - Ensure that Students are Learning (Ensure Learning), pgs. 40-52
- Five levels for scale of adoption

Scale of Adoption	Definition
Not occurring	College is currently not following, or planning to follow, this practice
Not systematic	Practice is incomplete, inconsistent, informal, and/or optional
Planning to scale	College is has made plans to implement the practice at scale and has started to put these plans into place
Scaling in progress	Implementation of the practice is in progress for all students
At scale	Practice is implemented at scale—that is, <u>for all students in all programs</u> of study

# Highlights from *Clarify the Path*

- Majors grouped into Meta-Majors
  - Meta-majors integrated into new website
  - Program Pathways Mapper published and integrated into the website
    - In addition to program maps, includes career and salary information for each major
  - Meta-majors are starting to become part of campus organization and student events such as the Counseling Department and New Student Welcome Day, College Night, and Warrior Welcome Week
  - Majors are grouped by Meta-majors in CCC Apply
  - Next Steps: Development of additional pathways, course sequencing, major information sheets, generally continue to adjust, enhance and improve various efforts
- **Scale of Adoption: Scaling in Progress**

# Highlights from *Enter the Path*

- Strong connections to high schools through dual enrollment, outreach, counseling;
- HDEV scaling up offerings
- Career Services website redesign to help undecided or uncertain students decide on a major
- Career events, including career panels and info sessions, offered in each meta-major
- Support courses in place for math and English
- Gateway courses identified for each meta-major
- *Next steps:* develop more robust onboarding into each meta-major including common first semester to increase exploration; start to plan and implement strategies to help more students succeed in gateway courses
  
- **Scale of Adoption: Scaling in Progress / At Scale**

# Highlights from *Stay on the Path*

- ECC Connect used for educational planning and tracking of students through progress reports and tracking items
- Course equivalency tables have been developed
- Success coaches hired for each meta-major, as well as in general counseling and special programs
- ECC has many programs in place to meet students' basic needs such as Warrior Pantry, Warrior Closet, and laptop and hotspot loan program
- Next Steps: plan and implement milestones; make sure all students have the correct major on file; input course equivalency tables into colleague; continue to promote and improve ECC Connect, including auto-flags and personal success plan (PSP); work on scheduling courses based on student need
- **Scale of Adoption: Planning to Scale/Scaling in Progress**

# Highlights from *Ensure Learning*

- SLOs, PLOs, ILOs assessed on a regular basis; new ILOs align with four pillars of Guided Pathways
- The college is starting to use Canvas Outcomes
- New program review template includes career and wage attainment outcomes
- A plethora of equity-minded professional development opportunities exist on campus (the newest one being EMTI)
- The myPATH model is being used in courses across many meta-majors, including BSS, LCJ, STEMs
- *Next Steps:* begin to assess new ILOs; implement Canvas outcomes for SLO assessment; continue to grow myPATH
