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- I) CTDC Updates – Michelle Moen
- Advisory Committee meeting on Tuesday, March 24
 - 424 units were paid for students in the fall.
 - 587 units are begin paid for students in winter/spring.
 - The California Dept. of Education will not longer be paying coordinators to help students apply for and receive the funds. The college will not be managing the funds. The college may pay a coordinator to assist students, or students will need to apply directly to the California Department of Education. This will begin in fall.
- II) Bright Horizons (possible collaboration) – Michelle
- Bright Horizons is interested in hosting students as a practicum site.
 - They would like to hold a resume writing workshop.
- III) Spring 2021 – CDEV 115 and CDEV 110 – Michelle
- An afternoon section of 115 is offered every three years.
 - In spring 2021, Michelle recommends 1 online, 1 one afternoon, and 1 evening section of 115.
 - CDEV 110 fills well in Winter
- IV) Future Teachers Club – Janice

- The club is growing and holding 3 events, a School of Education College Recruitment event, a panel of people who work in education, and a CDEV permit workshop.

V) CDEV 125

- There are 55 students enrolled in two sections.
- Fingerprinting for the sites is an issue. It costs from \$50-\$140. Funding may be sought from the Foundation.
- The class takes a ton of preplanning.
- The CTEA funding for mentor teachers is going away and will make it hard to find sites.
