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Curriculum Transition

- CurricUNET is read only this semester and can be used to view course outlines, certificates, and majors while the transition is taking place.
- We are migrating to new catalog and curriculum software. Acalog for the college catalog and Curriculog for curriculum.
- Acalog will integrate changes made in Curriculog shortening the change process.
- During this transition we will be using a paper process Janet Young has in place for this semester.
- Courses reviewed and approved by the DCC this semester will be reviewed at CCC next semester with the exception of CDEV courses emailed for approval. The Curriculum Chair will use these courses to test in new system.

Ready for Review for Spring 2019 Submission

- The Division Curriculum committee will review courses this semester that will be forwarded to the CCC for review in spring 2019.
- The proposers of HIST 110, 111, 128, and SOCI 112 have submitted updates to Bev, all courses had only minor changes. Those changes will be made using the paper process. A list of changes will be sent out for approval, hard copies will be available as well.
- In addition, HIST 129, 140, 141, PSYC 12, and SOCI 102 are scheduled for review. Bev will distribute outlines to proposers for update and forward changes to the DCC.
- The committee voted to keep the scheduled DCC meeting dates for this semester in place should any major changes be made to any of these course outlines
- If only a minor change is made such as textbook update a spreadsheet with change for each course will be emailed for approval.

DCC Approval – Submission to CCC Fall 2018

- Proposed inactivation of ANTH 12 and CDEV 154 were approved.
- CTE 2-year review were submitted for CDEV 126, 129, 130, 131, 152, and 165.
- Spreadsheet with list of changes made to each course were sent out by email.
- All CDEV courses listed were approved to be forwarded to the CCC for review.

Guided Pathways

- Guided Pathways was discussed. The need to be involved is important, even more so for areas where curriculum is struggling for enrollment.
- Next Friday, September 28th Guided Pathways is scheduled. The dean encouraged attendance and involvement.
- Laurie Houske stated lack of involvement could impact future enrollment if course are not included in the pathway.
