Health Services School Nurse Credential	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BA degree or higher • Possession of Registered Nurses License • Completion of school nurse credential program
Teacher Librarian Services Credential	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BA degree • California teaching credential • Completion of Teacher Librarian Services credential program
Pupil Personnel Services Credential (for school counselors, psychologists, social workers, and child welfare/attendance officers)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completion of post-baccalaureate degree of study (units vary)
Speech Language Pathology Services Credential: Language, Speech and Hearing Language, Speech, Hearing and Audiology Also have special class authorizations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Master's degree in Speech Language Pathology • Commission approved specialist program
Designated Subjects CTE/Adult education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Three years of related experience and/or education (depending on the subject) • High school diploma or GED or foreign equivalent
