Course Review

The committee members reviewed, discussed, and approved the changes to the following course proposals:

- Business 25
- Computer Information Systems 16
- Computer Information Systems 28
- Computer Information Systems 134

- Law 19
- Paralegal Studies 1

These proposals will be approved and forwarded for CCC review.

The following courses were approved for inactivation.

The following two courses were presented for DCC approval, per consent of the CIS department. The committee members reviewed the updated course outlines, and agreed to move forward in the review process:

No changes were required for Computer Information Systems 133; therefore, it was decided that this proposal should be removed from the review process. The committee members also decided to delete Computer Information Systems 132 and Computer Information Systems 135 from CurricUNET.

Proposals:

- All proposals must have Department and Division concurrence prior to any data entry into CurricUNET.
- When entering a proposal into CurricUNET the author must include department faculty, Laurie Linka, and Dean Rapp as co-contributors to ensure ongoing participation in the process.

Modifications and Updates:

• All modifications and updates to existing courses must include department faculty, Laurie Linka, and Dean Rapp as co-contributors.

All proposals, modifications, and updates will be discussed at the Division DCC meeting prior to submission to the CCC. CCC review comments and change requests on proposals, modifications, and updates will be forwarded back to the DCC for final division approval prior to final vote at the CCC.
