M. Chaban called the meeting to order at 1:34 p.m.

### **Course Review**

N. McGrue presented Real Estate 12A for review.

Revisions to the course outline included updating the representative textbook and adding a Distant Education addendum to include online/hybrid offering. After review and discussion, the committee voted to approve. This proposal will be forwarded to L. Plum and J. Young for CCC review.

V. Rapp congratulated M. Som de Cerff on the fact that Business 28 has been accepted as an O.E.I. course. Business 29 is pending the same designation. M. Chaban noted that according to L. Suekawa, it should be reviewed by the end of April, and we should receive notification by early May.

M. Chaban requested that the departments begin working on their Fall 2020 Curriculum plans very soon, and to include the courses which will be part of the course renumbering process. We will need to send a list of the courses to L. Plum, as consideration must be made to degrees and certificates that are affected by the changes.

- Online training certification many were omitted from the list
