Chair Young explained that the Assessment of Learning Committee (ALC) has recommended the following procedures: A) If a course comes to the CCC with fewer than three SLOs, faculty will be contacted and reminded that, unless formal approval has been given by the ALC, all courses need three SLO statements. Faculty will be asked to add additional SLOs during the review process. If an issue arises, the course may still be approved by the CCC, however the lack of three SLOs will be noted in the CCC minutes. The Division Facilitator, Dean and the SLO Coordinator will be notified by the Curriculum Office and faculty and facilitators will be responsible for following up; B) If course SLOs are revised during the course review process, faculty completes the SLO Change Form and submits it to the SLO Coordinators; and C) When a new course is approved by the CCC, faculty submits the New Course SLO Form to the SLO Coordinators.
